ARTS

Empowering arts programs to enrich every corner of campus and making sure creative thought informs every student's education strengthen Carolina's teaching, research and public service missions, and position Carolina as a national leader in transforming the 21st-century liberal arts education.

505001 - Ackland Art Museum - This fund provides general, unrestricted support to help sustain the Ackland Art Museum's core services of collection conservation, research, exhibitions, education programs and free admission.

505007 - Ackland Art Museum Director's Discretionary Fund - This fund is used at the Museum Director's discretion for programs and initiatives of top priority to the mission and vision of the Ackland Art Museum.

505016 - Ackland Art Museum Conservation Fund - This fund supports the conservation and care of the more than 18,000 works of art in the Ackland Art Museum's permanent collection.

505043 - Ackland Art Museum Exhibitions and Special Projects Fund - This fund provides essential support for the Ackland Art Museum's world class exhibitions and special programming, all offered free of charge.

806270 - Carolina Performing Arts Annual Fund - This fund provides general, unrestricted support to curate and present exceptional arts experiences that inspire and provoke the UNC community and beyond and celebrate the intrinsic value of the creative process.

ATHLETICS

The impact of Carolina athletics is undeniable. Our distinctive blue-hued uniforms adorned with that iconic argyle are often the first things that come to mind when people think about the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill-but there's so much more. 515101 - Athletic Association - This fund supports the Carolina Athletic Association, which serves as the liaison between students and the Athletic Department in order to voice athletic concerns and promote UNC Varsity Sports.

779701 - Educational Foundation-Annual Giving (Ram's Club) - This fund sustains the athletics scholarship program and meets many other critical needs of Carolina Athletics.

CHILDREN'S WELLNESS

UNC focuses on enhancing the lives of children and families through clinical care, advocacy, interdisciplinary research, technical assistance, professional development, education and implementation science.

204361 - Children's Dental Treatment Fund - This fund supports dental care for financially disadvantaged children being treated at the UNC School of Dentistry.

343427 - Children's Program Fund - This fund supports four areas of need: clinical care, advocacy, research and education. Unrestricted gifts to the Children's Program Fund allow UNC Medicine to quickly and effectively fund these areas and help the brightest minds in pediatrics to deliver top-quality, family centered care to young patients.

480913 - Frank Porter Graham Child Development Institute - This fund supports research, professional development, and outreach related to child development, early care and education and individuals with developmental disabilities.

484182 - James J. Gallagher Dissertation Award -

This fund provides financial support for dissertation research at UNC focusing on issues related to child development and family support. Priority is given to research on young children, children with disabilities or children with gifts and talents.

488102 - National Clearinghouse on Autism

Evidence and Practice - This fund allows FPG Child Development Institute to identify evidence-based practices for individuals with autism and provides free online instruction for teachers and families on how to plan for, use, and monitor these practices.

075441 - Project Uplift and Recruitment Programs

-This fund enables high-achieving, rising high-school seniors to experience academic rigor and social climate of life on the Carolina campus. This early recruitment program provides prospective students with insight into the UNC-Chapel Hill undergraduate experience.

075442 - Diversity and Multicultural Affairs

- This fund supports the University Office for Diversity and Inclusion to create a welcoming and inclusive environment for all members of the UNC community —faculty, staff, students, and communities, local and beyond.

075473 - American Indian Center – This fund supports a university-wide public service center designed to advance the University's mission of research, education, and service with three primary goals: provide leadership in American Indian scholarship and research, engage with and serve Native populations and enrich campus diversity and dialogue.

100104 - Carolina Asia Center – This fund supports the Center in their mission positively transform their understanding of and relationship with Asia and to equip students and others with the knowledge of Asia to assume leadership roles.

ENVIRONMENT

Advancing the world is only possible if it's a clean, sustainable place to live, and preserving the environment is a job for everyone. At Carolina, we are working to create, advance and implement clean technology to help drive economic growth and develop technology breakthroughs supporting water and food security, among other initiatives.

400749 - Institute for the Environment – This fund supports the Institute's commitment to the health and sustainability of the ecosystems on which life depends. They work with partners to tackle issues from multiple perspectives to fuel discovery and innovation, turning scientific research into solutions for local and global communities.

525201 - Botanical Garden Foundation – This fund supports the North Carolina Botanical Garden, its mission, and its programs. The Foundation and its Board of Directors raise nearly 50 percent of the funds for operating expenses of the Garden. In addition, the Botanical Garden Foundation protects nearly 300 acres of land for conservation purposes.

565143 - Galapagos Science Fund – This fund supports the partnership between Carolina and the Universidad San Francisco de Quito (the leading university in Ecuador), which is dedicated to saving the Galápagos Islands for future generations. These islands are in crisis now, but your participation will help UNC faculty and students carry out this important scientific mission.

GLOBAL IMPACT

Infusing a global dimension throughout Carolina's teaching, research and service activities drives the University's international initiatives and programs.

043205 - Chancellor's Global Education Fund – This fund is the only pan-university fund supporting Carolina's strategic global priorities. Gifts to the fund allow University leaders the flexibility to provide funding to students, faculty and programs supporting Carolina's top global priorities.

070760 - World View: An International Program for Educators – This fund supports World View, a public service program at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill that equips K-12 and community college educators with global knowledge, best practices and resources to prepare students to engage in our interconnected and diverse world.

474538 - The Dhiren R. and Kailas Global Pharmacy Scholarship Endowment Fund - This fund provides program support, travel and housing expenses for student international experiences through the Global Pharmacy Scholars program at the UNC Eshelman School of Pharmacy.

606030 - Campus Y Reserve Fund - This fund is used by the Campus Y Director to support core program activities across the entire organization - public service locally and overseas, social entrepreneurship and advocacy - wherever they are needed most.

GENERAL SUPPORT

Unrestricted funds allow our schools, departments and units to meet unanticipated needs and fulfill the most overarching funding priorities for their areas.

000001 - Chancellor's Unrestricted Fund - This fund helps fulfill the most overarching funding priorities on campus. Unrestricted funds are vital to both the day-to-day operations of Carolina and to the long-term success of the University.

050585 - School of Government Foundation - This fund helps strengthen financial support for faculty teaching and research, statewide education programs, student scholarships, staff development, and general operating needs.

060702 - Morehead Planetarium and Science Center - This fund allows the Morehead team to invest strategically in areas of vital importance to the organization and its mission.

101501 - Arts and Sciences Annual Fund - This fund plays a crucial role in supporting the College's highest priorities—recruiting and retaining faculty, enhancing student engagement, deepening academic excellence and achieving global impact. This support helps shape the experience of nearly every student in the College.

171730 - The Fund for UNC Kenan-Flagler - This fund supports the students, faculty and programs that make UNC Kenan-Flagler great and are applied to the areas of greatest need at the School - such as increased scholarship and fellowship support.

222201 - School of Education Greatest Need - This fund provides the School of Education with the flexibility to meet immediate needs and respond to opportunities for students and faculty as they arise.

232303 - Graduate School Dean's Fund - This fund allows The Graduate School to provide unrestricted support to areas directly connected to graduate student degree completion, career success and impact at UNC-Chapel Hill.

242401 - School of Media and Journalism Foundation Unrestricted Fund - This fund provides the school's Foundation Board flexible funding to respond to the MJ-school's highest funding priorities.

252501 - Law Foundation Unrestricted - This fund supports and promotes teaching, research and service at the School of Law. The foundation encourages the establishment of endowment funds for purposes including, but not limited to, professorships, visiting professorships, fellowships and scholarships.

494901 - Social Work Foundation - This fund supports the School of Social Work's three distinct campaign priorities (1) program support for academic excellence, (2) faculty support to nurture professional growth and (3) social justice and racial equity as their touchstone.

575701 - University Library – This fund strives to meet the needs of University Library users by focusing on supporting and enriching their world-class collections, creating spaces that enable new styles of learning and inquiry, and building research capacity.

HEALTH

UNC Health Care focuses on innovating and driving transformational change in research, education and practice across the entire life span and health spectrum.

202022 - The Dental Foundation Gift Fund – This fund provides flexibility for the School of Dentistry to address the needs of the students, staff, and faculty at the dean's discretion; examples include but are not limited to: purchasing equipment, providing financial assistance to student groups, supporting travel for faculty, students and staff, and building repairs.

202079 - Student National Dental Association – This fund serves to support the Student National Dental Association in their mission to promote a viable academic and social environment that is conducive to the mental health of minority students.

204359 - Dental SHAC - This fund supports the Student Health Action Coalition (SHAC) Dental Clinic, a student-run clinic for members of the surrounding community in need of emergent dental services. Its main purpose is to provide for those who are otherwise unable to access dental care.

343564 - Medical Alumni Loyalty Fund - This fund advances the medical education mission to train the next generation of Tar Heel Doctors who will care for the health of our state, the nation and the world. Loyalty Fund gifts support scholarships, foster academic excellence for students and faculty, and build community.

345818 - UNC Medical Discovery Fund - This fund provides critical support of UNC Medicine's mission to provide a healthier future through medical education, research, and patient programs. Resources are directed to where they are most needed, or where opportunities are greatest.

373724 - Lineberger Comprehensive Cancer Center – This fund supports UNC Lineberger's faculty and staff in their work to treat cancer patients, conduct cutting-edge cancer research, and train future physicians and scientists.

394002 - Friends of the Health Sciences Library - This fund helps make available guides and resources for those seeking consumer health information.

424201 - Nursing: Expendable – This fund provided unrestricted support to the UNC School of Nursing to support their priorities of teaching, research and service.

444580 - Public Health Foundation – This fund supports the UNC Gillings School of Global Public Health through their commitment to four thematic goals: deliver proven solutions faster; promote health, prevent disease and improve care for all; invest in bringing about healthy people and a healthy planet; and harness big data for health and well-being.

474553 - The Robert A. Blouin Fund (Eshelman School of Pharmacy) – This fund honors former UNC Eshelman School of Pharmacy Dean Bob Blouin and to support faculty research, education and practices initiatives.

474829 - Pharmacy Building Fund – This fund will be put to immediate use for renovation needs.

474810 - Pharmacy Advancement Fund – This fund will be put to immediate use in the area of greatest need.

research and analysis to help policy makers use data and evidence to inform decision making as they tackle complex issues affecting their communities.

051516 - NC Judicial College Endowment -

This fund educates and trains judicial officials at all levels, including judges, magistrates, and clerks of court, through training, continuing education seminars and online programs.

the School of Education's Minor in Education, a program for students interested in issues surrounding education, such as educational equity, the achievement gap and education reform. 228599 – Graduate Student Support - This fund provides support for graduate students and enables the School of Education to recruit outstanding students who will transform education at all levels. Gifts allow graduate students the opportunity to attend professional conferences, conduct research and engage in intellectual discovery.

244222 – Media and Journalism Graduate Program - This fund provides operating support for the MJ-school graduate program.

244227 – Media and Journalism Awards - This fund is used to provide monetary awards to MJ-school students to support educational and immersive experiences.

422604 – The Miller & Moore Nursing Student Resource Materials Fund - This fund supports the purchase of study materials for the resource room as well as the food pantry for students in need.

422613 – Ruth C. Lynn Short Term Student Aid Fund - This fund provides emergency funding for School of Nursing students in need.

424237 – Nursing-Scholarships - This fund provides unrestricted scholarship support for School of Nursing students.

474820 – Pharmacy Scholarships and Awards Fund - This fund provides financial support for our outstanding and deserving students.

545405 – William and Ida Friday Fund for Lifelong Learning - This fund provides unrestricted support to the William and Ida Friday Center for Continuing Education so that learners from all walks of life have access to the University's outstanding faculty, extensive knowledge base, and groundbreaking research.

600616 – Parents Council Grants Fund - This fund supports new and innovative programs/events that benefit undergraduate students through UNC offices and student organizations. Since its inception in 1985, the Parents Council Grants Program has provided more than 1.7 million dollars in grant funding to enhance the quality of undergraduate student life and learning at UNC.

606201 – Vice Chancellor's Unrestricted Fund (Student Affairs) - This fund is used to support activities to enhance the life of the student which they may not otherwise have the ability to do. A gift to this fund will allow the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs to support premier student programs and provide new and innovative experiences outside of the classroom.

606359 – Student Emergency Fund - This fund assists Carolina students by providing financial support when they need assistance with unexpected emergency expenses surrounding situations such as accidents, illness, death of a family member, fire damage or need for temporary housing. Students may apply for funds when they have exhausted all other resources.

656253 – Carolina Covenant Scholarships General Fund - This fund provides unrestricted support to the Carolina Covenant, a financial aid, mentoring and support program that provides low-income students with the opportunity to graduate from UNC debt-free.

656296 – Chapel Hill Scholarships Unrestricted Support - This fund allows the Office of Scholarships and Student Aid the flexibility to use gifts when and where they are needed most. This is particularly critical to meeting emerging demands and unforeseen opportunities.

757532 – Morehead-Cain Annual Fund - This fund provides unrestricted support to the Morehead-Cain Merit Scholarship Program.
